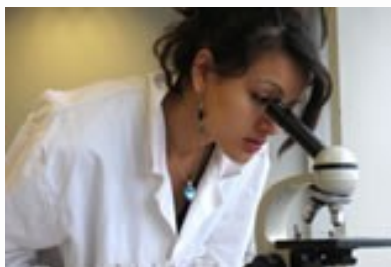

In late September, a number of Innovation Centre tenants rose to the challenge of giving detailed feedback from the entrepreneurial coal face to European Commission's Deputy Director General for Enterprise, Daniel Calleja. Mr Calleja, who was accompanied by advisers from the Commission and the UK Department for Business, Innovation and Science, is the Special Envoy for SMEs. He outlined plans for cutting red tape, access to finance, access to markets and creating a European Enterprise Network. He said Cambridge was a rare exemplar of cooperation between academia and business, but accepted that deploying the 'Cambridge model' elsewhere is difficult given the different strengths and histories of other clusters.
